

The Venerable Canon Arthur Copeman

Archdeacon Arthur Copeman is currently the Clergy member of the Anglican Consultative Council and has attended meetings of the Council in Zambia and Hong Kong, with another meeting expected next year in Ghana. Arthur is also a member of the Anglican Communion Church Planting Network and from this Network has been invited to a meeting of the Anglican Commission on Evangelism and Discipleship in London in July this year.

In the Australian Church Arthur is a member of the Standing Committee of the General Synod and the Executive of that Standing Committee. Arthur is also a member of the Panel of Electors for the Primate.

Arthur is the Archdeacon of Newcastle and a Canon of Christ Church Cathedral, Newcastle. Amongst Arthur's Archdeacon duties he has responsibility for Clergy Professional Supervision within the Diocese. Arthur is also the Rector of All Saints ANeW Parish, based in New Lambton in the city of Newcastle, where he leads a Team Ministry. This Parish is one which grew primarily from a Church Plant which Arthur established just over ten years ago.
