I was subsequently promoted to Principal Policy Analyst and finally the Director for the State's Adoption and Permanent Care Services. After 17 Years at DoCS I took up the position of General Manager at The Northcott Society and was subsequently invited to become CEO for Interaction Disability Services in 2005. I retired from Interaction on the 31st of July 2020.

Professionally, I am on the Board of the Australian Prader-Willi Syndrome Association (PWSA) and the International Prader-Willi Syndrome Organisation. (IPSWO).
