Ministry journey

Mark was born in Broken Hill and grew up in Sydney. Following ordination in 1988, he ministered in Lalor Park and North Sydney prior to his appointment as rector of St Andrew's Roseville in September 1991. He became rector of Noosa, Queensland in November 2009. Having always had a heart for the Anglican church of Australia, he was keen to serve outside of Sydney.

Mark was elected Bishop of Bathurst in September 2019, and consecrated and installed in November 2019.



As a result of COVID, he has a ministry across the diocese via YouTube, producing a weekly sermon online for his many parishes (16/29), without clergy.
