About

Born and raised in Perth to Baptist parents, I was received into the Anglican Church in 2009 after three years of pastoral ministry with the Baptist Union of Victoria. I am an historical theologian by training, with a particular research expertise in the theologies of Karl and Markus Barth, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, Jewish-Christian relations, and post-*Sho'ah* theologies. I have also published two major works on the doctrines of election and providence with IVP Academic, and T&T Clark. I have a long-term passion for and engagement in theological education, having taught for the past 20-odd years in theological colleges and seminaries around Australia and overseas. I have held research fellowships with the University of St Andrews, the Woolf Institute (Cambridge), and Princeton Theological Seminary. Prior to joining the faculty at Trinity College Theological School in 2015, I served for nearly a decade as Director of Research at the University of Divinity. I have been a Council member with ANZATS (the Australian and New Zealand Association of Theological Studies) since 2016, and President since 2019. In 2018, I served as Visiting Episcopal Chaplain at Chautauqua Institution, in New York.

I have been happily married for 26 years, and have three excellent boys, the eldest of whom was ordained as deacon in August 2021. I also love my two dogs, the Liverpool Football Club, and good single malts (not necessarily in that order!).
