Richard is the 12th Bishop of Tasmania, commencing in this role in March 2016. He leads the Diocesan Vision to be *a Church for Tasmania, making disciples of Jesus*, which is showing some great signs of growth and renewed ministry. He chairs Anglican Health and Welfare which provides Chaplains to hospitals and prisons, works with the Board and CEO of Anglicare to love and serve the Tasmanian community, is Visitor to the three Tasmanian Anglican Schools, and is involved in various bodies in the Anglican Church of Australia. Prior to coming to Tasmania, he was the Vicar of St Jude's Church, Carlton for 14 years, one of Melbourne's largest Anglican churches, and was Archdeacon of Melbourne. He was Lecturer in New Testament at Ridley College (an Anglican training college) from 1995-2002. His formal educational qualifications are in Social Science, Theology, and Ministry. Richard is married to Helen and they have two adult children.
