Originally from Queensland, Ken has been Dean of Holy Trinity Cathedral, Wangaratta since 2014.

Before ordination, Ken worked in the Queensland Justice Department and in the Finance Department of the Brisbane City Council.

Ken studied at the University of Queensland (Arts) and trained for ordained ministry at St Francis Theological College. He was ordained Deacon in 1993 and Priest in 1996, at St John's Cathedral, Brisbane.

Ken has served in the parishes of Milton, Caloundra-Glasshouse Country and Moorooka-Salisbury in the Diocese of Brisbane, as well as St. Peter's Eaton Square in the Diocese of London.

Ken has also served on the School Council of Cathedral College, Wangaratta; on the Board of St. John's Retirement Village, Wangaratta; as well as on the Board of Governors of St. Peter's Eaton Square Church of England Primary School in London.

Ken is married to Stephanie and they have two adult children, Zoë and Jacob.
