Reverend Victor Joseph, Ordained as a Priest in 2007 at St Paul's Anglican Church (North Queensland Anglican Diocese), St Paul's Community. Moa Island. Torres Strait. Previously worked as the CEO of the Island Council for 9 years prior to the amalgamation.

In 2008 was appointed to the College Principal of Wontulp-Bi-Buya College Ltd and continued to work and provide ministry to all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island people in the Cairns area.

Through the College and part of a team Victor works in providing education and training to all Aboriginal and Islander people around Australia in theological ministry training, mental health and social and emotional well-being, and community development.

Through his ongoing ministry Victor was appointed as the LOCUM of St Luke's CATSIM – Cairns Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Ministry on the 27th of November 2016.

In September 2018, Victor was appointed by Bishop Bill Ray to the Cathedral Chapter St Marks Canonry.

In November 2019, Victor was appointed to the ABM Board for the Provincial Representative for Queensland. Victor became the first Indigenous appointment onto the ABM Board.

Most recently Victor was appointed onto the School of Indigenous Studies Committee at the University of Divinity.

Victor's passion is the impact of training with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, and is especially focused on the Governance of Church leadership and sharing about Indigenous Contextual theology to the national Church.
